What is 5S?

5S is the name of a workplace organization method that uses a list of five Japanese words that translate roughly to sort, shine, store, standardize and sustain. It describes how to organize a workspace for efficiency and effectiveness by minimizing time wasted looking for stuff. The method works like this:

- Step 1. **Sort** –Remove everything from the area. Retain only the items that are needed. Reuse, recycle or shred (if appropriate) what is not retained.
- Step 2. Store Return items to the area in logical places. A place for everything and everything in its place!
- Step 3. Shine Clean the area and look for ways to keep it clean.
- Step 4. **Standardize** Systemize the maintenance and of the first 3 S's. Label storage areas. Take a picture of the newly organized area and post it to show what the expectation is.
- Step 5. Sustain Stick to the rules. No backsliding. Spread the rules to other areas of the workplace.
